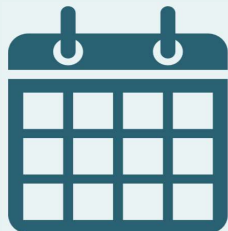
“Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.” Philippians 2:4

WHEN WE WILL MEET?

Our first meeting will be Sunday, June 14th at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.

We will be holding two separate services with time in between for cleaning.

A maximum of 50 people each service with overflow space in the annex building (up to 50 people)



WHAT WILL THE SERVICE LOOK LIKE?

The order of worship will be:

- Announcements/Opening prayer
- Songs
- Scripture reading
- Lesson
- Song(s)
- Communion/closing prayer

Songs will be on the overhead screen (We will not use the songbooks.)

WHAT ABOUT COMMUNION AND CONTRIBUTION?

No trays will be passed. We will be using individual communion packets which you will find in the back of the building as you enter.

You can continue to mail your contribution to Travis Rogers or place your contribution in the designated plate as you enter or exit the building.



WHAT HAPPENS AFTER SERVICES?

At the conclusion of the service we ask that you dismiss orderly, maintaining social distancing. We ask that you please exit expeditiously and do not visit or congregate outside.

Upon exiting the service, each party (person or family) should remove all items that they brought, so the area can be sanitized before the next service.

WHO SHOULD STAY HOME?



Those who are vulnerable, sick or have symptoms should stay home. We ask that if you have one of the following symptoms, please stay home for the safety and well being of your brothers and sisters: fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, and/or chills.

We will continue to offer our Sunday morning service online for those who cannot or should not join us in person.

WHAT ABOUT FACE MASKS?

Wearing a mask is optional, but strongly recommended.



It is strongly recommended by the state that masks be worn when entering or exiting the building, and when possible while seated (they can be removed for singing and partaking of the communion). Exceptions for masks - children under 2, those with trouble breathing, or those unable to remove a mask without assistance. We ask that you bring your own masks, but if you do not have one, one will be provided at the door.

WHERE AND HOW WILL WE SIT?



Social distancing (6 feet) is necessary when: entering, exiting, and while seated in the building.

WHAT ABOUT RESTROOM USE?

If restroom use is necessary, please ensure you sanitize the area using the provided materials before exiting.

ANYTHING ELSE?
